

SAKLAN VALLEY SUMMER MUSIC LESSONS!

Dear Parents:

The Saklan Valley Instrumental Music Program continues during the summer. Private lessons are offered either at school or in your home on piano, guitar and the orchestra instruments. Lessons begin the week of June 15th. These lessons are open to all students: continuing students, new students, students in the summer day camp, and those who may wish to come to school just for the lessons. The schedule will be arranged around your vacations and your child's summer activities.

SUMMER MUSIC TUITION: Summer music lessons are paid for three at a time, but there is no charge for any lessons that are canceled with at least 24-hour notice to your child's music teacher. The per-lesson rate remains the same as during the school year (rounded off). Lessons at school are \$29 per 30-minute lesson, \$43 per 45-minute lesson. Lessons at home are \$35 per 30-minute lesson, \$52 per 45-minute lesson. If any books or supplies are purchased for your child, you will be billed for this separately.

We sincerely hope that many of our present students will continue lessons during the summer so as not to lose skills gained during the school year. Summer is also a good time for children to begin lessons—without the pressure of homework competing with practice time! We would like to have all registration forms by Thursday, May 28th. Thank you!

INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC LESSON REGISTRATION AND AGREEMENT

I, the undersigned, am the parent of a child who wishes to enroll in the Instrumental Music Program (“Program”) offered through Instrumental Music for Children LLC. (“IMC”). This document is an agreement (“Agreement”) between myself and IMC.

IMC agrees to provide independent contractor/teachers who will provide instrumental music lessons to my child. I understand that IMC is agreeing only to provide qualified music teachers who will provide music lessons to my child as stated below. I agree to hold IMC, together with its agents, managers, and employees, harmless from any claim which does not arise from its duty to provide independent contractor/teachers who are qualified to give instrumental music lessons under this Agreement.

I understand that a lesson that needs to be missed must be canceled by a call to the music teacher at least 24 hours in advance in order to avoid a charge for the lesson.

Please make checks payable to IMC (this stands for Instrumental Music for Children) and mail this form along with your payment for the **first 3 lessons**, (**School Lessons**: \$87 for 30-minute lessons or \$129 for 45-minute lessons; **Home Lessons**: \$105 for 30-minute lessons or \$156 for 45-minute lessons), to IMC, P.O. Box 2053, Danville, CA 94526. (Please do not combine a school-year payment and a summer payment on the same check. Thank you!)
